(iii) New Tree Preservation Order: Name (Ref: 2018/00002/IND)

Councillors are asked to consider a Notice which has been received from Wiltshire Council (available in the Office) of a Tree Preservation Order for 1 Copper Beech, 1 Walnut and 2 Norway Maple trees on land at Showell Nursery. The Order took effect, on a provisional basis on 18 January 2018. Wiltshire Council has made this Order "to protect trees that will be situated in future residential curtilages and to safeguard the visual amenity and character of the local area". This Order will be confirmed within 6 months. Any objections or comments must be made by 16 February 2018.

6. PROPOSED TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURES/TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

(i) <u>Consultation: Proposed Pedestrian Crossing at Lodge Road, Pewsham</u>

To consider proposals to install a zebra crossing at Lodge Road, Pewsham. A copy of the press release and location plan provided by Wiltshire Council are attached. The consultation period ends on 26 February 2018. At the PET Committee meeting held on 6 October 2016 the Town Council agreed to support this project (CATG Issue 3013) and to contribute £2,000 towards the cost.

(ii) Pre-consultation - Extension of current 40mph limit Patterdown Road

Councillors are asked to consider the following information received from Wiltshire Council:-

In preparation for the new residential accesses which will take direct access from Patterdown Road it has been decided to implement a lowered of the speed limit along the lines of the below schedule:

<u>Schedule</u>: The revocation of the current 50 mph limit and the extension of the existing 40 mph limit on Patterdown from its current termination point (a point 95m south of the southern access to the layby adjacent to number 1 Patterdown) to a point approx. 355m to the South (a plan is attached).

<u>Statement of Reason:</u> For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs; in the interests of highway safety.

- (iii) To note the following temporary closures to enable essential work:-
 - (a) Lowden (part) from its junction with Palmer Street from 15 17 March 2018 between the hours of 08700 and 1700.

- (b) Ripon Close from its junction with Minster Way from 9 − 12 March 2018.
- (c) Spinney Close from its junction with Queens Crescent to its junction with The Firs and The Firs (part) from its junction with Spinney Close from 11 13 March 2018.
