

Proposed Statement – for Issue by the Chippenham Town Centre Partnership Board

The Chippenham Town Centre Partnership Board met on Friday 10th of March at Chippenham Town Hall.

The main item for discussion on the Agenda was the proposed consultation process for the 'Chippenham One Plan' a delivery focussed plan to support the economic regeneration of Chippenham Town Centre. This plan will be focussed around a series of projects in the town centre that will be consulted on in the coming months. It is hoped the consultation will help shape these plans and economic regeneration priorities that will in turn support efforts to secure funding and deliver the projects.

The Board Agreed to review a proposed consultation strategy presented at the Board and feedback comments to finalise an agreed consultation plan and programme.
