

Chippenham Town Centre Partnership Board 8th September 2023:

Statement summarising the discussions and key decisions

The Chippenham Town Centre Partnership Board met on Friday 8th September at Chippenham Town Hall.

The main item for discussion on the Agenda was the outcome of the recent consultation on the 'Chippenham One Plan', which took place for 6 weeks between April and June.

The Board agreed to provide feedback on the Consultation Output Report that was presented so that a final version of this report can be issued in advance of the next board meeting for endorsement as an accurate record of the One Plan Consultation process. This will enable the Consultation Output Report to be placed in the public domain and used by partner organisations to support the next steps.
