

Chippenham Town Centre Partnership 25th October 2024 (online meeting):

Statement summarising the discussions and key decisions

The Chippenham Town Centre Partnership Board had a virtual meeting on Friday 25th October.

The main item on the Agenda was a presentation by Acorn Properties for the Emery Gate proposals, followed by a discussion. The planning application for Emery Gate is scheduled to be submitted at the end of October. The Environment Agency also gave an update on the River Project. The Board noted the importance of managing the disruption these two projects will have on the town centre when construction begins.

Board members will also provide feedback on the latest iteration of the Terms of Reference to inform discussion at the next meeting on Friday 24th January 2025.
